Abstract: The title should be brief (Times Roman font size 14, bold, centered), followed by authors name and affiliations (Times Roman font size 10, bold, centered), Abstract Text (Times Roman Font size 12) . The corresponding author's full mailing address including e-mail address should be included in the footnote. The main abstract should be compiled in the following order - Title, Authors and Affiliation, Background, Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusion, Keywords.
 Abstract should reach us on or before 07.01.2017 on E-mail of symposium : ehms2017@gmail.com
 The screening committee will select the abstracts for poster presentation. All selected abstracts will get informed by 10th January 2017 by E-mail.
