

Hospice:

Mahavir Cancer Sansthan caters a large population of Bihar and adjacent states, besides neighbouring countries, like Nepal and Bangladesh. Approximately, 30-40 % cases still attend our hospital in very advanced stages of the disease where no curative treatment can be offered. They actually need good care of the symptoms and maintenance of nutrition. The pain and palliative care is to provide best possible care for such cancer cases. Many of these patients proceed to terminal stage of life and to look after such patients, Hospice (House for Terminal Care) has been created. The present hospice of Mahavir Cancer Sansthan has a capacity of 51 beds situated in the very posh area of the city and well-equipped with the transport system. This Hospice is part of the Mahavir Cancer Sansthan where we provide almost free care.
